

Directions to the Rome Ballroom at University of Connecticut – S Lot

(For additional assistance, see map at <http://www.uconn.edu/campuses/pdf/wholemap.pdf> and the interactive map of the University of Connecticut Storrs campus at <http://admissions.uconn.edu/virtualtour/search/>. On the latter map, you will be entering campus from the right side on RTE 195 (Storrs Road). The S Lot is labeled “S Lot” behind RSRH labeled on map”. The Rome Ballroom is in the “ROME” building, which stands for the Lewis B. Rome Commons.

A. From the West (heading through or from Hartford):

1. Take **Interstate 84 East** through Hartford continuing to **Exit 68**.
2. **Turn Right** off the exit ramp. Follow this road (**Route 195 or Storrs Rd**) all the way into the University of Connecticut campus (7 miles to UConn).
3. After you cross **Route 44** **turn Right at the 5th set of lights** onto **Bolton Road**.
4. After only ~100-200 yards look for S Lot sign on your right.

B. From the East (heading from Boston towards Hartford):

1. Take **Interstate 84 West** through Hartford continuing to **Exit 68**.
2. **Turn Left** off the exit ramp. Follow this road (**Route 195 or Storrs Rd**) all the way into the University of Connecticut campus (7 miles to UConn).
3. After you cross **Route 44** **turn Right at the 5th set of lights** onto **Bolton Road**.
4. After only ~100-200 yards look for S Lot sign on your right.

C. From the Southeast:

1. Take **Interstate 95 to 395 North**.
2. Take **Exit 81 West to Route 32 North**.
3. Follow **Route 32 North** to Willimantic. In town, turn right and go over bridge. Continue straight through the light and follow 195 North for 8 miles to campus)
4. After passing E.O. Smith High School **Turn Left** onto **Bolton Road**.
5. After only ~100-200 yards look for S Lot sign on your right.

D. Walking directions from the S Lot to the Lewis B. Rome commons

1. The entrance to the **Lewis B. Rome** building will be the Southwest side of the S Lot (on your left). The Nathan Hale Inn is located nearby for assistance.
2. After entering the L.B. Rome building, proceed up the stairs to the left (or take the elevator on the right) one floor up to reach the lobby of the Rome Ballroom.
