LIBRARY COURSE RESERVES

- ✘ TCR (Traditional Course Reserve)
 - + Library books
 - + Media
 - + Personal copies
- ✘ ECR (Electronic Course Reserve)
 - + Linking
 - + Scanning
 - + Streaming

LIBRARY COPYRIGHT POLICY

✘ Scanning for ECR

- + 1 article or 15% of journal
- + 1 chapter or 15% of book
 - ✘ (need title page and page with © symbol)

✘ Linking to Full Text Resources

- + Linking recommended over downloading
- + License agreement may restrict use
 - ✘ May not allow downloading PDF's to HuskyCT

LIBRARY COPYRIGHT POLICY

✘ Video Streaming

- + Streams made from legal copies owned by the Library for which we have obtained streaming rights.
- + Streams purchased from vendors

✘ Videos (DVD, VHS)

- + Library owned
- + Instructor owned originals

NOT ACCEPTED FOR RESERVE

✘ TCR

- + Anthologies
- + Photocopies
- + Workbooks or other consumables
- + ILL books
- + Examination copies of textbooks for which no order has been placed for classes.
- + Copies owned by other Libraries outside of UConn system.

NOT ACCEPTED FOR RESERVE

✘ ECR

- + Material not owned in original format by instructor, Library or the University. (physical or subscription)
- + Anthologies
- + Workbooks or other consumables
- + Examination copies of textbooks for which no order has been placed for classes.

NOT ACCEPTED FOR RESERVE

- ✘ Videos (Media Reserves and Streaming)
 - + Leased, e.g. Netflix, Itunes, Blockbuster
 - + VHS to DVD transfers without permission of copyright holder
 - + Homemade rips without proof of rights
 - + Copies owned by other Libraries outside of Uconn system.

VIDEO STREAMING SELECTION

- ✘ Priority given to:
 - + Multiple classes / campuses
 - + One class → Multiple semesters
 - + Non-resident student populations
 - ✘ Regional campuses
 - ✘ Distance learning
 - + Blended classes

STREAM FACTS

- ✘ Cost ~\$300
- ✘ Short term (3-5 years)
- ✘ Feature films (1 year)
- ✘ Renewable based on use
- ✘ Allow lead time

 - + Theatrical releases: sometimes
 - + Sports (NFL, NCAA): probably never
 - + Things shown on PBS: sometimes
 - + Foreign films: sometimes
 - + UConn owned content: almost always
 - + What we have

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE?

- ✘ Several days when we have an existing relationship with the vendor
- ✘ Weeks to months if the vendor is new and we have to negotiate a contract.
- ✘ Please give us all the advance notice you can give.
